London 2012 Olympic athletes to compete on Mondo

Leader in sports flooring to be official supplier for 10th time

LONDON – June 1, 2010 – Five world records were set on the track at the Beijing Olympic Games, including Usain Bolt's amazing performances in the 100 and 200 meters. When the world's greatest athletes descend upon London for the 2012 Games, they'll have at least one of the same advantages that Olympians enjoyed in 2008: the world's fastest track.
